- 401** U.S. Springfield Model 1884 trapdoor rifle, 45-70 cal., 29" barrel, blue and case hardened finish, wood stock, #554693. This gun is in overall good condition showing a light brown patina on the barrel and brown patina mixed with a silvery finish on the lock plate, trapdoor, frame and trigger guard; the bore shows some rough areas, the action is crisp, the barrel is V, P proofed with eagle head, on the top of the butt plate is stamped "8 F 2" (8th Infantry, Co. F?); stock is overall good with no visible inspector cartouches, scattered wear, nicks and mars from carry and storage; ramrod is missing. Est.: \$175-\$350.
- 402** Arabian "camel" long gun, exterior lock mechanism, approx. 58 caliber, 44" barrel, near full wood stock. This gun is in overall fair + condition showing an old cleaning to the barrel and nine hammered metal barrel bands, dark bore, action needs work, lock is inlet into the wood stock crudely; bone decorative inlays in the butt stock and at the top of the wrist; the wood stocks show wear and scattered old shaping, losses along the barrel channel ; old repairs to the back end of the butt stock; cleaning rod retained. This gun is in overall fair + condition showing an untouched patina to the metal surfaces, wood, mountings and inlays. There are also a number of inlays that show red coloring; some just the metal or bone inlays, etc.; the lock functions but does not remain on full cock. Est.: \$300-\$600.
- 412** U.S. Springfield All-in-type trapdoor conversion to cartridge forager, 20 gauge, 28" shortened barrel, wood stocks, #NVSN. This gun is in overall good condition as modified showing a brown patina on barrel with scattered areas of erosion, silvery lock plate, hammer and trapdoor with sharp markings, lock dated 1864 and the trapdoor dated 1866 with eagle head proof. The action is good, the bore bright, the top of the iron "US" marked butt plate is stamped "23" and "A 7"; stock is in overall good condition with scattered scratches, nicks and mars from carry and storage; missing ramrod. These Frank Wesson rifles were a good quality cartridge arm, less expensive than repeaters and several were known to be owned by famous western individuals in the 1860's-1870's including John Clum of Tombstone.
