This gun is in overall very good condition with approx. 75% muted original military finish, all matching visible serial #s, good bore, sharp markings, Nazi proofed, good action. Est. \$1,000-2,000
- 79 Hammond Bulldog single shot spur trigger pistol, .44 cal., 4" octagon barrel, rare nickel finish, checkered gutta percha grips, #2452.
